

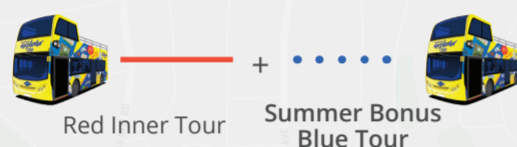

Bus Stop Cnr Hobson & Victoria St W  
Iconic Sky Tower, Federal Street dining precinct and Sky City Casino complex.
- 2** Wētā Workshop Unleashed  
Fantastic film effects workshop, explore the worlds of horror, sci-fi and fantasy in the making.
- 2** All Blacks Experience  
State-of-the-art guided encounter that showcases what it takes to make, shape and be an All Black.
- 3** Art Gallery (Free entry) & Queen Street  
Wellesley Street East  
Shopping, Auckland Art Gallery, Town Hall and Albert Park.
- 4** Newmarket  
359 Broadway, Newmarket  
Upscale retail district with designer fashion boutiques along Nuffield Street and Broadway, and stylish Westfield Newmarket mall.
- 5** Auckland Museum  
Outside South Entrance, Auckland Domain  
Discover New Zealand, Māori and Pacific history and culture
- 6** Holy Trinity Cathedral (Free entry)  
Corner St Stephens Ave & Parnell Rd, Parnell  
Beautiful 'Pacif Gothic' style Anglican cathedral
- 7** Parnell Village  
Bus stop outside 279 Parnell Rd, Parnell  
Boutique shopping and eateries amid charming historic buildings
- 8** Takaparawhau  
Bastion Point lookout (Free entry)  
Hapimana Street, Tamaki Dr, Orakei  
(Short walk to Mission Bay)  
Panoramic views over the city and harbour
- 9** SEA LIFE Kelly Tarlton's  
23 Tamaki Dr, Orakei  
View marine life including sharks, sting-rays, and Antarctic penguins!

- 5** Auckland Museum  
Outside South Entrance, Auckland Domain  
Discover New Zealand, Māori and Pacific history and culture
- 10** Wintergardens (Free entry)  
Kiosk Rd, Auckland Domain  
(Short walk from Auckland Museum)  
Historic glasshouses with exotic plants
- 11** Mt Eden/Maungawhau (Free entry)  
Puhū Huiā Rd, Mount Eden  
Walk to the top of an extinct volcano for stunning views of Auckland city
- 12** Eden Park/Kingsland  
New North Road/Kingsland Station  
Home of the famous All Blacks rugby team and perfect stop to explore the local cafés and shops
- 13** Auckland Zoo  
Motions Rd, Western Springs  
See native New Zealand animals up close, plus lions, tigers, giraffes, and more
- 14** MOTAT  
Great North Rd, Western Springs  
Museum of Transport & Technology: interactive science exhibits and historic collections
